Right now, I'm kind of strictly BC and Alberta, and I am trying to get into, like, more of the prairie style as that's... My mom's Assiniboine Sioux. So, I like to bring some, like, that culture here because you see a lot of the coastal art, and I want to kind of represent, you know, all of Canada. Even through like the Mi'kmaq's way over on the other side of Canada, you know, bringing some of their specialized pieces over here, and yeah. You know, just because we're that native boutique. So, I want to be that fashionable, stylish, trendy, Native fashion, but also, I want to bring that culture alive. And, you know, like, what better way is from a First Nation person and, you know, telling the story.
